May 1-June 15	PREQUALIFICATION PHASE OPENS – Organizations MUST attend (1) MANDATORY TRAINING before they can access the online software.

June 29	“Early Bird” Application Training from 3-5:00pm @ 1277 Ribaut Rd., Bft. - Training for programs that feel they meet the standards set forth in the pre-qualification phase and want to begin as soon as the application opens. This is the “Early Bird” training since organizations have not yet received the official decision on eligibility.
July 1	Notification of Eligibility – All programs will be informed of eligibility.
July 1-Aug. 15	ONLINE APPLICATION OPENS – Organizations can begin filling out the online application once they are informed of their eligibility. Application training <u>is not mandatory</u> , but strongly suggested .

August 15	DEADLINE – Must complete and submit online application by 11:59pm.
Aug. 16-Sept. 22	All applications are evaluated and scored, using established investment criteria, by the Community Impact Committee and Priority Councils. A weighted scoring matrix is used , and those programs that score the highest within each priority area will move forward in the funding process.
September 28	All programs are informed of whether they scored the highest within their priority area. Those that scored the highest will be provided a date and time for a site visit to occur with the trained volunteers who will be responsible for providing funding recommendations to UWLC’s Board of Directors.

December 6	Notification of funding is sent out to all programs who received a site visit and have been recommended for funding.
December 15	Grantee Memorandum of Agreements (GMOA’s) are sent out , via e-mail, to all programs recommended for funding.
January 15	DEADLINE – All programs receiving funding must provide their signed GMOA’s to UWLC.
