April 1	All new Community Impact information is populated on the UWLC website for non-profits to review.
June 1	<b>INTENT TO SUBMIT PHASE OPENS – Organizations will have 15 days to complete the online "Intent To Submit" information.</b> All <b>NEW</b> applicants <b>MUST</b> attend a training session before you can complete the submission process. If you are a returning applicant, this is optional.
June 1	NEW Applicant Intent to Submit Training from 9:00am - 11:00am - In Person
June 5	NEW Applicant Intent To Submit Training from 2:00pm - 4:00pm - In Person
June 15	<b>DEADLINE - Agencies must complete and submit their online "Intent To Submit(s)" before 4:00pm.</b>
June 29	Application Training Session #1 from 9:00am - 11:00am - In Person
July 1-31	<b>ONLINE APPLICATION IS OPEN – All <u>NEW</u> organizations MUST attend an application training session.</b> This training will provide a comprehensive overview of the CommunityForce software, as well as a detailed description of the information requested within each individual component of the application. There will also be two work sessions made available, where they will be given the opportunity to ask specific questions to increase the quality of their submission.
July 11	Application Training Session #2 (Brown Bag) from 11:00am - 1:00pm via ZOOM <i>(After the two scheduled training sessions, you will be provided the opportunity to schedule a 25 minute, one-on-one work session to ask specific questions to increase the quality of your application).</i>

September 29	All programs are informed via e-mail whether they advanced to the next round, depending on their application's cumulative score. Those that are progressing will be provided their site visit schedule
