Since 2007, VITA has provided **free, reliable tax preparation services** to thousands of Lowcountry residents. Staffed by IRS-certified volunteers, this program ensures eligible taxpayers file their returns accurately and receive all credits and deductions they've earned.

Why It Matters

- Available to individuals and households earning **\$69,000 or less per year**
- **IRS-certified volunteers** prepare federal and assist with state returns as a courtesy
- Claim valuable credits like the **Earned Income Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit, and Educator Expense Deduction**
- **Fast, accurate e-filing** with **direct deposit**
- All services are **completely FREE**
